If it is an emergency and you need to speak to someone, you can go to the Command Post on the blacktop.

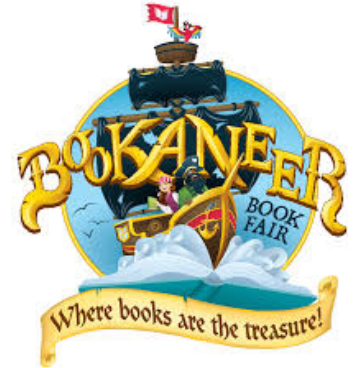
## **Scholastic Book Fair Oct 10-14**

**When students miss too much school— regardless of the reason – it can cause them to fall behind academically.** Your child is less likely to succeed if he or she is chronically absent. Children chronically absent in kindergarten and 1<sup>st</sup> grade are much less likely to read at grade level by the end of 3<sup>rd</sup> grade. By 6<sup>th</sup> grade, chronic absence is a proven early warning sign for students at risk for dropping out of school.

The October SELPA 1 CAC Coffee Talk will be **Special Education 101** by *Parents Helping Parents*.
