- 3. Discussed possibility of chairs of SSC, ELAC and PTA meet together 2x a year.
- 4. Jaime Saxena signed Recommendation and Assurance document for Site Plan
- 5. Jaime Saxena discussed District Task Force of developing 4 boundary proposals to be narrowed down to 2 eventually to present to school board. Target to be 450 students per school
